

Common Garage Door Repair Cost in West Hollywood

The usual garage door repair cost in West Hollywood is commonly about **\$125 to \$450** for a routine service visit and minor or moderate repairs. Larger repairs, damaged doors, and replacement work can increase the total to **\$500 to \$1,500 or more**. - **Evaluation and adjustment:** \$125 to \$250
- **Garage door spring service or replacement:** \$180 to \$450
- **Garage door cable service:** \$150 to \$350
- **Garage door roller replacement:** \$150 to \$350
- **Track service or replacement:** \$150 to \$500
- **Garage door panel repair:** \$150 to \$500
- **Garage door opener restoration:** \$150 to \$400

The final price depends on replacement parts, labor rates, the number of components involved, and whether the door needs a complete safety inspection after the repair. A technician should test balance, reversing sensors, cables, rollers, tracks, and the automatic garage door before regarding the job complete.

Garage Door Spring Repair and Replacement

A chain-drive opener is often one of the more affordable choices and is suitable for many detached garages.
