How the Game is Played

Every game round begins with a wagering phase. Gamers have a restricted time to put their chips on several of the 8 offered betting alternatives on the virtual layout. These choices include four numbers (1, 2, 5, and 10) and four distinct bonus games.

When wagering closes, the live host spins the huge wheel. Simultaneously, a separate two-reel slot placed above the primary wheel-- referred to as the **Top Slot**-- spins along with it.

The Top Slot Mechanism

Before the wheel stops, the Top Slot produces a random multiplier and assigns it to one of the 8 wagering alternatives on the wheel.



- If the Top Slot multiplier and the wheel outcome align on the very same section, the multiplier uses to that win.
- If the result is a reward game, the multiplier enhances all the multipliers *inside* that particular bonus round, causing possibly astronomical payments.

Comprehending the Wheel Segments and Payouts

The 54 segments on the Crazy Time wheel are dispersed amongst numbers and reward video games. Naturally, the lower-paying numbers appear far more regularly on the wheel than the rare perk rounds.

Breakdown of Wheel Segments

- **Number 1:** Appears 21 times (Payout: 1:1)
- **Number 2:** Appears 13 times (Payout: 2:1)
- **Number 5:** Appears 7 times (Payout: 5:1)
- **Number 10:** Appears 4 times (Payout: 10:1)
- **Coin Flip Bonus:** Appears 4 times
- **Cash Hunt Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Pachinko Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Crazy Time Bonus:** Appears 1 time

Dive Into the Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The real magic-- and the source of the video game's greatest payouts-- lies within its four interactive benefit rounds. Whenever the wheel lands on a bonus section, gamers who placed a bet on that specific function are transferred to a secondary game screen.

1. Coin Flip

The simplest of the four benefits, this round includes a coin with a red side and a blue side.

- Each side is designated a random multiplier before the flip.
- The host presses a button to turn the coin, and whichever color lands face-up awards the corresponding multiplier to the gamer's bet.

2. Cash Hunt

This is a huge interactive shooting gallery including a screen with 108 random multipliers concealed behind different symbols (like a cactus, target, or chef's hat).

- Players use a virtual crosshair to aim and shoot at a symbol of their choice before a countdown timer ends.
- Once time runs out, all symbols reveal their hidden multipliers, and the player wins whatever worth they shot.

3. Pachinko

Motivated by the standard Japanese arcade game, Pachinko includes a big wall filled with **bitz.io** physical pegs.

- The host drops a puck from the top of the board.

- The puck bounces arbitrarily down the pegs up until it lands in among the slots at the bottom, which includes a multiplier.
- If the puck lands in a **"DOUBLE"** slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again for an even larger payout.

4. Crazy Time

The crown jewel of the video game. When set off, the host opens a red door leading into a surreal, vibrantly colored virtual world including a huge, 64-segment mega-wheel.

- Gamers must choose among three flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow**.
- The host spins the wheel, and the flapper the gamer selected identifies their reward.
- This wheel includes **"DOUBLE"** and **"TRIPLE"** sectors. If the flapper points to among these, all multipliers on the wheel increase, and the wheel spins once again-- permitting wins to scale approximately the video game's maximum cap of 500,000 x!

Techniques for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is ultimately a game of chance dictated by RNG and physics, gamers frequently employ different wagering strategies to manage their bankroll and maximize their time playing.

Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe/Conservative Strategy:** Betting heavily on the numbers (1 and 2) along with a small cover bet on the bonus offer rounds. This technique yields frequent, smaller sized wins, keeping the bankroll stable for longer periods.
- **The Bonus-Only Strategy:** Ignoring the numbers totally and placing small bets specifically on the 4 reward rounds (Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, and Crazy Time). This technique is high-risk, high-reward, as it counts on hitting the relatively uncommon benefit sections to see a return.
- **The Spread Strategy:** Placing bets throughout a large range of segments (numbers and bonus offers alike) to ensure that a high portion of the wheel yields some kind of return.

Necessary Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed home entertainment budget plan before logging in and never chase losses.
- **Understand Volatility:** Bonus rounds do not struck on every spin. Anticipate dry spells while waiting for a perk to trigger.
- **Play for Entertainment:** Remember that live gambling establishment video games are developed mainly for enjoyable and home entertainment, not as a reputable source of earnings.
