4. Coinflip

A timeless 1v1 video game of possibility. 2 gamers wager skins of roughly equivalent worth. The system designates one player as Heads and the other as Tails, then flips a virtual coin. The winner takes the entire pot, minus a small platform commission (rake).

5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the professional scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match wagering is the go-to alternative. Users wager on professional teams utilizing odds calculated by the platform, similar to traditional sportsbooks.
