1. The Martingale Strategy

- **How it works:** The gamer doubles their bet after every loss. When they ultimately win, the revenue covers all previous losses plus an earnings equal to the original base bet.
- **The Risk:** Requires a massive bankroll and can quickly hit table limits or run out of funds throughout a long losing streak (e.g., several successive 1.00 x crashes).

2. The Reverse Martingale (Paroli)

- **How it works:** The player doubles their bet after every *win*, capitalizing on winning streaks, and resets to the base bet after a loss.

3. The Low Auto-Cashout Grind

- **How it works:** Setting an automated cashout at a really low multiplier, such as **1.10 x to 1.20 x**, aiming for high-frequency, little wins.
- **The Risk:** While win rates are high, a single 1.00 x crash or a fast succession of low crashes can quickly wipe out lots of small wins.
