Kinds Of CS2 Cases

1. Active Drop Pool Cases

These are cases presently dropping to players actively playing on Valve official matchmaking servers. Because of the high supply, their market rates are usually low (often under £ 1.00 GBP).

- *Examples:* Kilowatt Case, Gallery Case, Recoil Case.

2. Unusual (Discontinued) Drop Pool Cases

When Valve presents a new case, older cases are normally pressed into the "rare drop swimming pool." They seldom drop after matches, meaning their supply is strictly limited. As players open them, less exist, driving up the cost.

- *Examples:* Huntsman Weapon Case, CS: GO Weapon Case 3, Operation Breakout Weapon Case.
