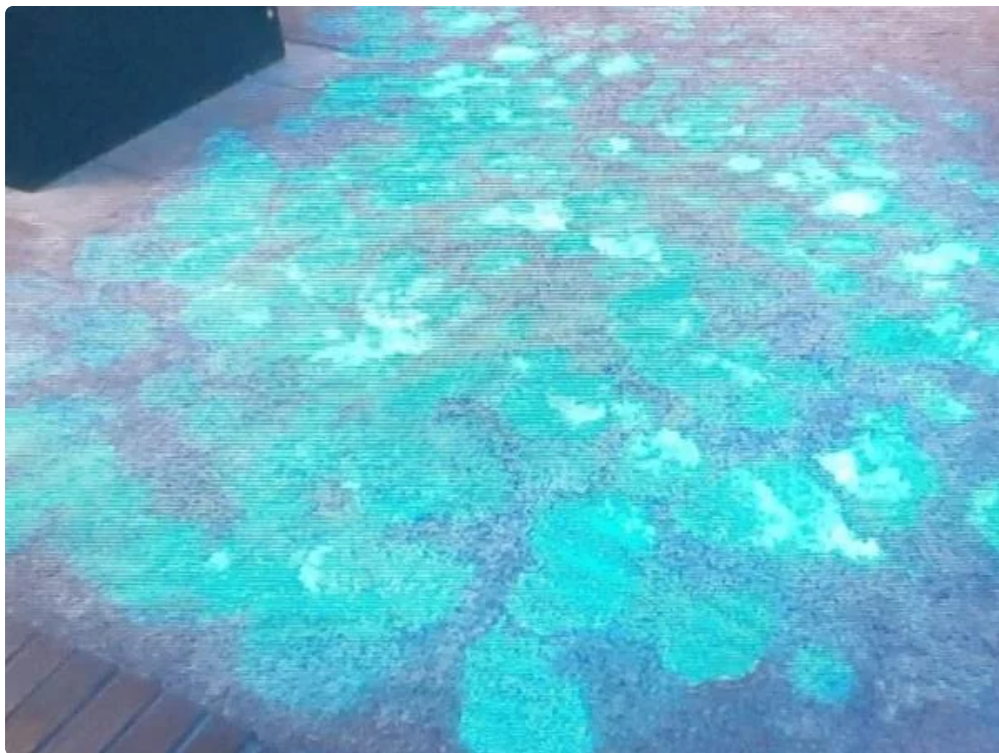
Methods that really match your carpet
