Core Strategies for Winning CS2 Battles

1. **Utility Stacking**-- With dynamic smoke, teams combine flashbangs and Molotovs to produce "smoke-holes" that give vision while blocking firing line of sight.
2. **Map Control Early**-- Securing crucial choke points (e.g., mid doors on Mirage) before the challenger can set up defaults forces them into undesirable retakes.
3. **Economy Discipline**-- Winning the very first few rounds typically dictates the whole half. Smart buy-backs and saving can swing the momentum in vital rounds.
