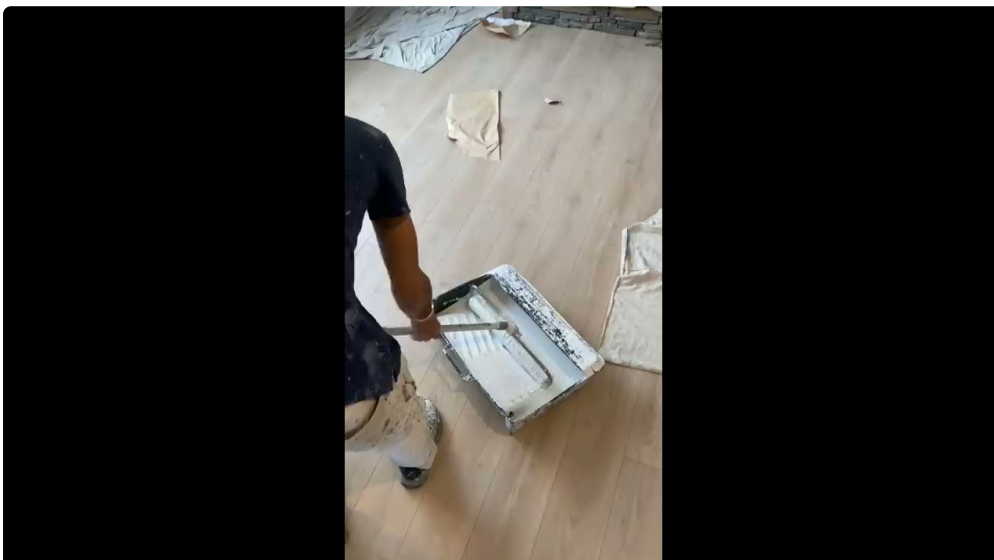

Three months later, we did a courtesy inspect. No blockading, no sags, and the stairwell looked flat at sundown.
