

Park Strip Flipping and Xeriscaping in Northern Utah That narrow strip of grass between the sidewalk and the curb is one of the hardest sections of any yard to keep alive, and Liberty Hill Landscapes has built park strip flipping into a full xeriscaping service for homeowners across Weber, Davis, and Morgan Counties. The process replaces thirsty turf with drought-tolerant plantings, gravel, or strategic sod where it still makes sense, cutting water use while still giving the strip a finished, intentional look instead of a bare gravel bed. Because park strips sit in full sun with limited soil depth, plant selection matters as much as installation, and the crew chooses species that hold up to Northern Utah's heat, wind, and alkaline soil.

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The project wraps with a full cleanup and care instructions, so homeowners know exactly how to maintain the new design through its first year. Many clients pair a park strip flip with a broader front yard refresh, since the two projects share the same drought-tolerant design language. Beyond the park strip flipping work itself, a few things set Liberty Hill Landscapes apart for Ogden area clients, and most of it [landscaper ogden](#) comes down to how the company is actually built and run day to day. The company's official service area spans nineteen communities across Weber, Davis, and Morgan Counties, including Ogden, North Ogden, South Ogden, Roy, Willard, Layton, Farmington, Kaysville, Syracuse, Clearfield, Clinton, Bountiful, Centerville, Woods Cross, North Salt Lake, Hooper, Eden, Hill AFB, and Morgan County. The company was founded in 2023 and has grown its client base one project and one referral at a time across Weber, Davis, and Morgan Counties, rather than leaning on national advertising to bring in work. It is a track record that shows up consistently across the company's Weber, Davis, and Morgan County client base.
