

A cracked windshield is not a cosmetic problem. Treat it that way and you gamble with visibility, crash performance, driver-assistance systems, and your own schedule. That matters because your windshield does more than block wind. It is part of the vehicle's safety structure. Greensboro drivers know how fast weather can flip from humid and mild to cold rain or blazing sun. Conditions matter during field service.
