Start with the room's eye line, not the fire

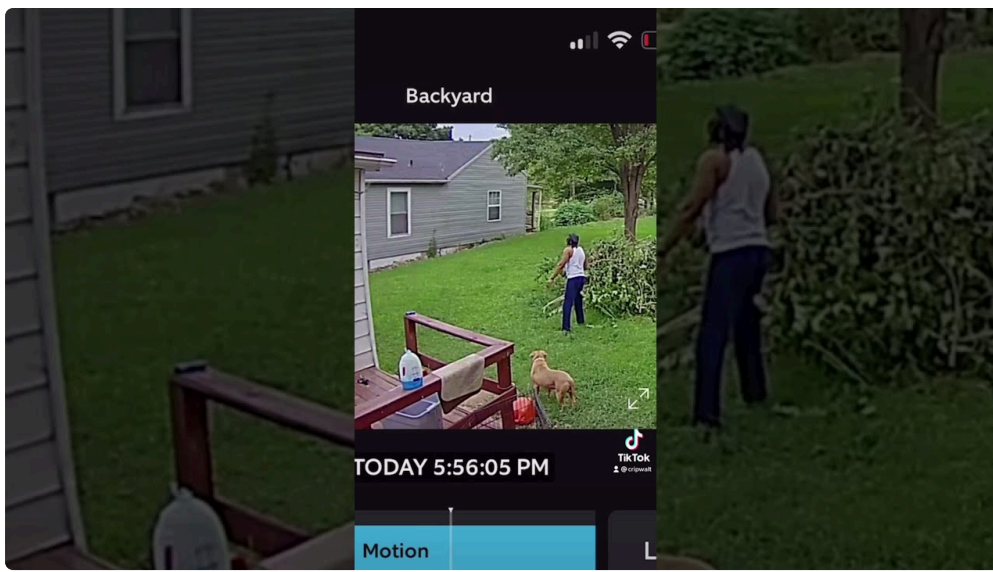

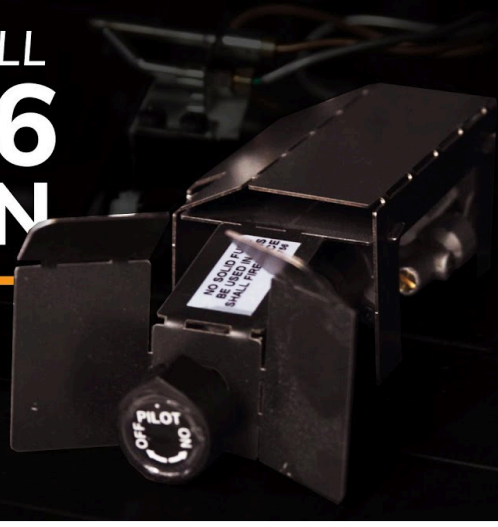
