## Visible Stains & Odors

Check for discoloration, warping, or persistent musty smells.

## Uneven or Spongy Floors

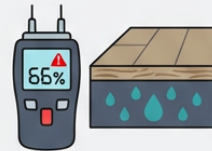
Test for soft spots, bouncing, or significant unevenness underfoot.

## Use a Moisture Meter

Employ a professional meter to get accurate subfloor readings.

## Lift Flooring to Inspect

Carefully peel back carpet or flooring in an inconspicuous area for a direct look.
