When the ceiling is definitely wild, I use a stepped method. The cupboard carcass stops 1 to 2 inches shy, then a paint-grade fascia bridges the ultimate bit, scribed and caulked. Carcasses do the heavy lifting; face frames and doors are the smile. In tall runs, I favor components and joinery that keep excellent over peak. For paint-grade, three/4 inch plywood with hardwood face frames resists racking.
