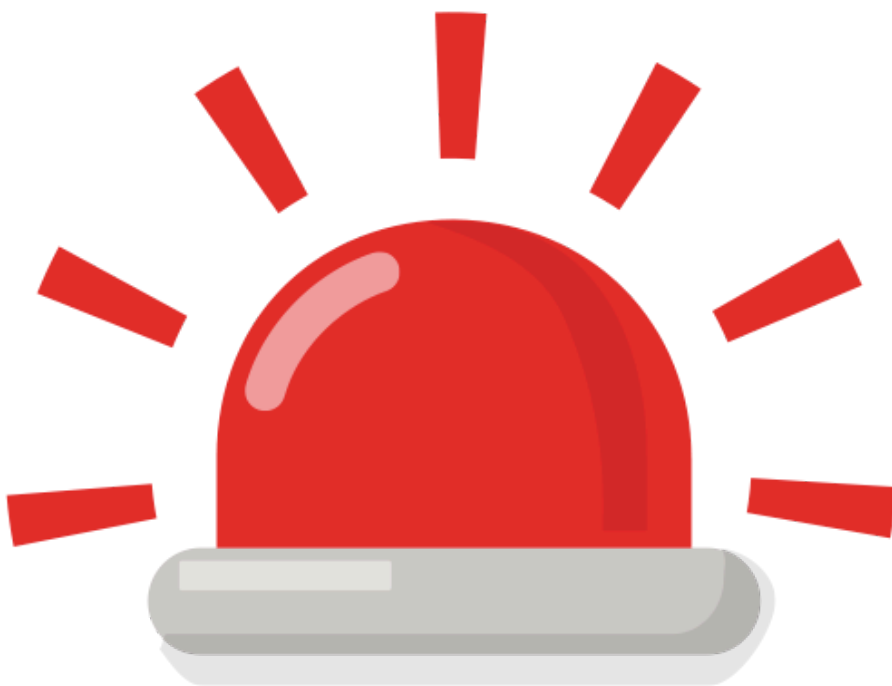
Why the same truck may handle more than one type of problem

Why ignition trouble deserves patience
