Do not push a stuck door or disconnect safety mechanisms to make it operate. If the door is crooked, suddenly heavy, unusually loud, or hanging from one side, stop using it and arrange an inspection.

When to Call for Garage Door Spring Replacement Near Me

A torsion spring is mounted above the door and twists to store energy. An extension spring is positioned along the horizontal tracks and extends as the door moves.
