



Can an Event Professional Help with a Post-Celebration Meal Following the Original Occasion?

To put it simply: yes. The more detailed answer is: it relates to what you need, your available resources, and the coordinator you work with.



A "thank you" gathering is in effect a different celebration from the original celebration, and most planners are quite willing to assisting with both if you'd like that.

The main factor to evaluate is the question of the occasion will be like or unlike the first gathering in its approach, attendance, and space.

If the luncheon is a modest, easy-going get-together with the same people, your professional might be able to deal with it as a follow-up of your primary package at a reduced cost.

How Planners Can Help with a Thank-You Luncheon

A planner can assist with essentially all the components of a follow-up gathering just as they do the main party.



This includes finding and booking the venue, managing food arrangements or culinary services, managing the guest [Kollysphere Events](#) list and RSVPs, planning fitting aesthetics for a brunch-style, informal gathering, and coordinating the timeline at the time of the luncheon.

They can additionally take care of the arrangements of transitioning from one event to the other if the events are happening on different days or if they're at the same time.

Budget Implications

The cost of adding a secondary celebration to your planner's services will depend on the extent of their involvement.

If the post-party meal is very simple and doesn't call for much additional work, they may ask for less money or include it as a gesture if you've already contracted them for the original occasion.

If it's a different, sizable celebration, they'll likely charge their standard rate for a separate event.

The most effective strategy is to be clear with your coordinator about what you want and request their recommendations on how to set up the agreement for the most cost-effective approach.

Picking Your Services

Not every post-event gathering demands extensive coordination. You might prefer execution support if you're handling the planning yourself.

Or you might prefer full planning services if the thank-you meal is more demanding or detailed than you originally anticipated.
