Note: The specific probability for a specific knife (e.g., Karambit|Fade) is a fraction of the uncommon special item pool.

These numbers highlight that the overwhelming bulk of openings will produce standard skins, not knives. The low probability makes knife openings a high-risk, high-reward activity.
