⚠ Warning: The Martingale system needs an enormous bankroll and is dangerous due to the fact that of table limits and long losing streaks. Hitting 8 or 9 crashes in a row at 1.00 x or below 2.00 x is completely possible and will rapidly wipe out your funds.

2. The Reverse Martingale (Paroli System)

If the standard Martingale is too stressful, the Reverse Martingale concentrates on profiting from winning streaks while keeping losses very little.

- **How it works:** You double your bet after every **win**, and reset to your base bet after every **loss**.
- **Objective:** Ride a hot streak of 3 to 4 wins in a row, then squander and reset. This safeguards your core balance while letting your house's money trip during a streak.

3. The Low Multiplier Auto-Cashout Strategy (Conservative)

This method focuses on consistency and durability over enormous, life-changing payments.

- **How it works:** You set an **Auto-Cashout** at an extremely conservative multiplier, usually in between **1.15 x and 1.30 x**.
- **Pros:** The analytical likelihood of a crash taking place below 1.20 x is fairly low compared to greater multipliers, implying you will win the large bulk of your rounds.
- **Cons:** Because the multiplier is low, a single 1.00 x instantaneous crash can clean out the revenues collected from 10 or 15 successful rounds.
