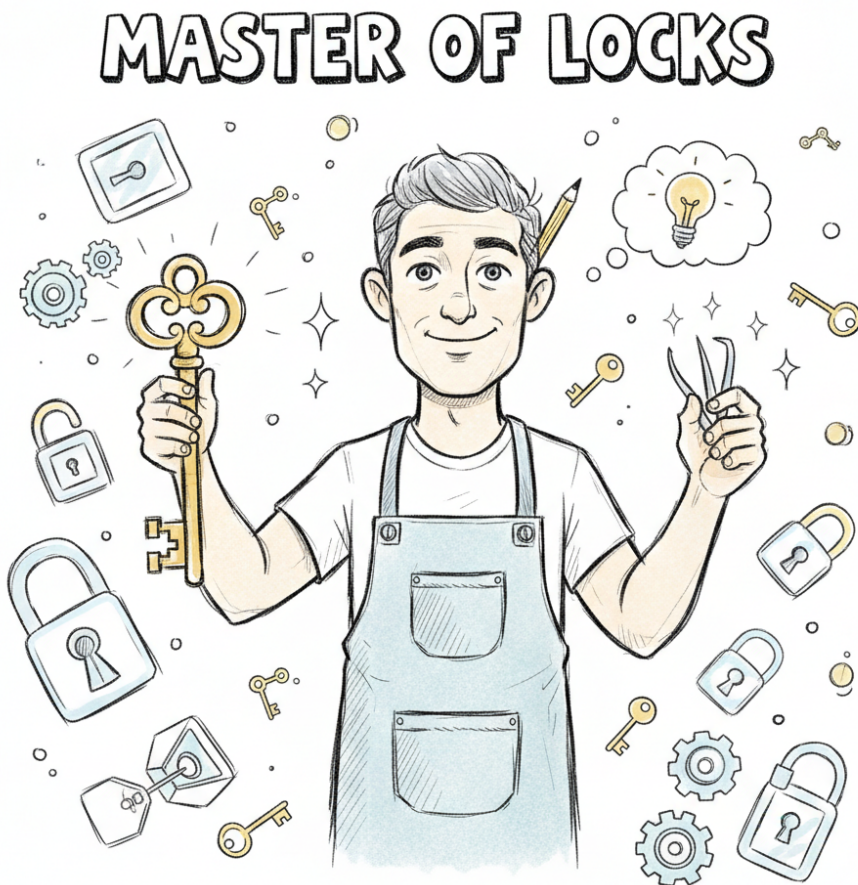
How home and apartment calls are usually handled
