In a loft preservation with concrete floors, the customer desired a stone monolith. We used a leathered black granite with subtle flow, double waterfall ends, and integrated steel angles throughout the island for tension. The darkish legs grounded the distance and coupled with black-framed windows. The seam close to disappeared when you consider that the granite's circulation become tight and non-directional. The best modification I may make in hindsight is to lift the toe by means of 1/eight inch greater. Industrial flooring are hardly ever fantastic, and the installer needed to do greater scribing to forestall a sunlight line at the base.

A couple with a love for true marble insisted on a full-height Statuario waterfall. We wide-spread that etching could show up, so we centred on craft. The retailer vein-matched higher to leg, and we set a subtle shadow divulge, a 1/8 inch set-lower back wherein the vertical meets the cabinet aspect, to frame the stone like a panel. The effect appeared intentional in preference to simply mass. They seal every year and dwell with the patina. When a chip appeared after a heavy pot clipped the corner, a educated fix tech crammed and polished it in an hour. The repair is invisible until you capture the faded simply proper.

Alternatives That Capture the Spirit, Without the Price

If you like the electricity of a waterfall yet not the money, there are clever core alternatives. A partial return, shedding purely 6 to 12 inches down the aspect, can secure the cupboard and supply a framed appearance with no a full slab.
