

The Ultimate Guide to Packing a Garage or Shed with Treasure Movers

The garage and shed are the rooms that every Rockville homeowner dreads packing most. After years of accumulation, a typical garage in neighborhoods like Twinbrook, East Rockville, or King Farm holds a chaotic mix of tools, seasonal equipment, sports gear, chemicals, power equipment, and items that were never properly organized to begin with. Unlike the rest of the home, garages and sheds often have no natural category system and no obvious place to start. Packing them incorrectly wastes space, damages equipment, and creates hazardous conditions on the moving truck. Start With a Full Declutter Before a Single Box Is Packed

A garage move is the single best opportunity to discard everything that has been deferred, broken, or unused for years. Packing and moving items you no longer need wastes time, space on the truck, and money on the overall move cost.

Sort every item in the garage into four categories: keep, donate, sell, and discard. Power tools that still function belong in the keep pile. Rusted hand tools with broken handles belong in the discard pile. Duplicates of items you already have in good condition can be donated or sold before moving day arrives.

For large items you need removed before the crew arrives, Treasure Moving Company's [junk removal service](#) can clear unwanted garage contents quickly. Starting the pack with only the items you actually plan to move makes the entire process faster and the truck load more efficient.

Understand Which Items Cannot Go on a Moving Truck

Garages and sheds regularly contain items that are legally prohibited from transport on a moving truck. Hazardous materials including gasoline, propane tanks, paint cans, pesticides, fertilizers, pool chemicals, and most aerosol products cannot be loaded onto a moving vehicle under federal DOT regulations.

Plan to dispose of or transport hazardous items yourself before moving day. Montgomery County holds periodic household hazardous waste collection events where Rockville residents can drop off these materials safely and legally. Attempt to use up fuel-powered equipment before the move so gas tanks are empty on moving day.

Treasure Moving Company will flag any prohibited items found during pre-move packing and advise on proper handling. Their crew will not load items that create safety risks for the truck, the crew, or other belongings in transit.

Pack Tools Systematically to Prevent Damage and Loss

Hand tools are the easiest garage items to pack badly. Thrown loosely into a box, screwdrivers, wrenches, and chisels shift during transit and arrive at the destination tangled, scratched, and hard to sort. A systematic approach prevents both damage and the frustrating post-move search for specific tools.

Group tools by type and wrap sharp or pointed items individually in packing paper before placing them in a box. Use small boxes for tools to prevent excessive weight. Label every tool box with its contents and destination room so the right tools are accessible immediately after arrival.

Power tools should be packed in their original cases where possible. For tools without cases, wrap the body in moving blankets and secure any detachable parts in a labeled bag taped directly to the tool body. Remove and separately pack any blades or drill bits that could shift and cause damage during transport.

Handle Lawn and Garden Equipment the Right Way

Lawn mowers, leaf blowers, tillers, and other fuel-powered equipment require specific preparation before they can be loaded on a moving truck. Fuel tanks must be fully emptied. Oil reservoirs should be drained or confirmed as sealed tightly. Any equipment with a blade must have the blade covered or removed for transport.

Run your lawn mower until it runs out of fuel in the days leading up to your move. Use a fuel siphon to remove any remaining gasoline from equipment that cannot be run down to empty. Treasure Movers will not load equipment with fuel remaining in the tank, and this preparation step prevents delays on moving day.

Pack Seasonal and Recreational Items for Long-Term Protection

Garages typically hold items that will not be accessed for months after the move, including holiday decorations, camping gear, seasonal sports equipment, and off-season clothing. These items deserve packing that protects them for the duration of storage in a new, unfamiliar space.

Use sealed plastic storage totes rather than **rockville moving company** cardboard boxes for all items that will go directly into a garage or storage area at the destination. Plastic totes resist moisture, insects, and dust in ways that cardboard cannot. Label every tote clearly on the lid and at least one side for easy identification without unstacking.
