The repair is usually straightforward once the tank is discovered. Mark it. Boost gain access to. Keep records. Those three steps avoid an unexpected quantity of future frustration.

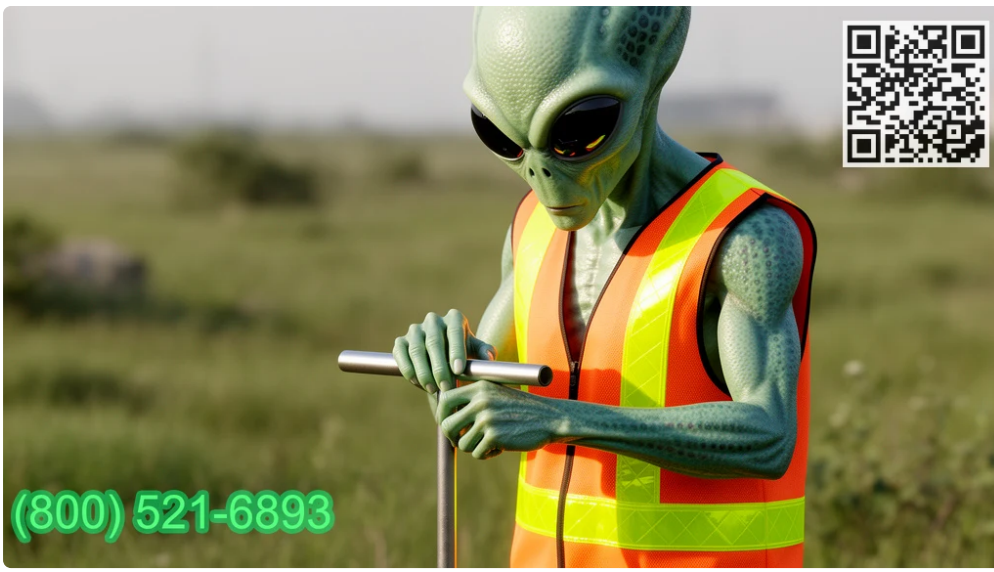
