Gamers need to exercise extreme care.

- A number of these websites require visiting through Steam, which can expose accounts to phishing rip-offs or API rip-offs.
- Platforms that ask users to deposit funds or products just to open a "complimentary" case are usually predatory.
- Valve actively punish betting and unauthorized trading bots, meaning users risk having their Steam stocks trade-banned.

Stick strictly to official Valve drop systems and the main Steam Community Market to keep accounts totally protected.

Regularly Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. Do I require CS: GO/CS2 Prime Status to secure free cases?

Yes. To be qualified for weekly case drops and item drops, your Steam account must have Prime Status. Non-prime accounts do not get random item drops or profile XP rewards that activate the weekly care bundle.

2. The number of free cases can I get each week?
