

Most appliances have a manufacturer-rated lifespan of 10 to 15 years, but that timeline depends heavily on OEM part availability and lead times. When critical components become discontinued or backordered, your appliance's practical lifespan ends far sooner, even if the unit itself could technically operate longer. Parts scarcity is the hidden factor that shapes whether repair remains viable or replacement becomes your only option.

How Does Part Availability Affect the True Lifespan of Your Appliance?

Dishwasher pump seals, washing machine drum assemblies, and dryer thermal fuses follow similar patterns. A seven-year-old washing machine is not old—but if the drum bearing assembly or clutch has been discontinued by the manufacturer, that washer is now effectively unrepairable through conventional means. 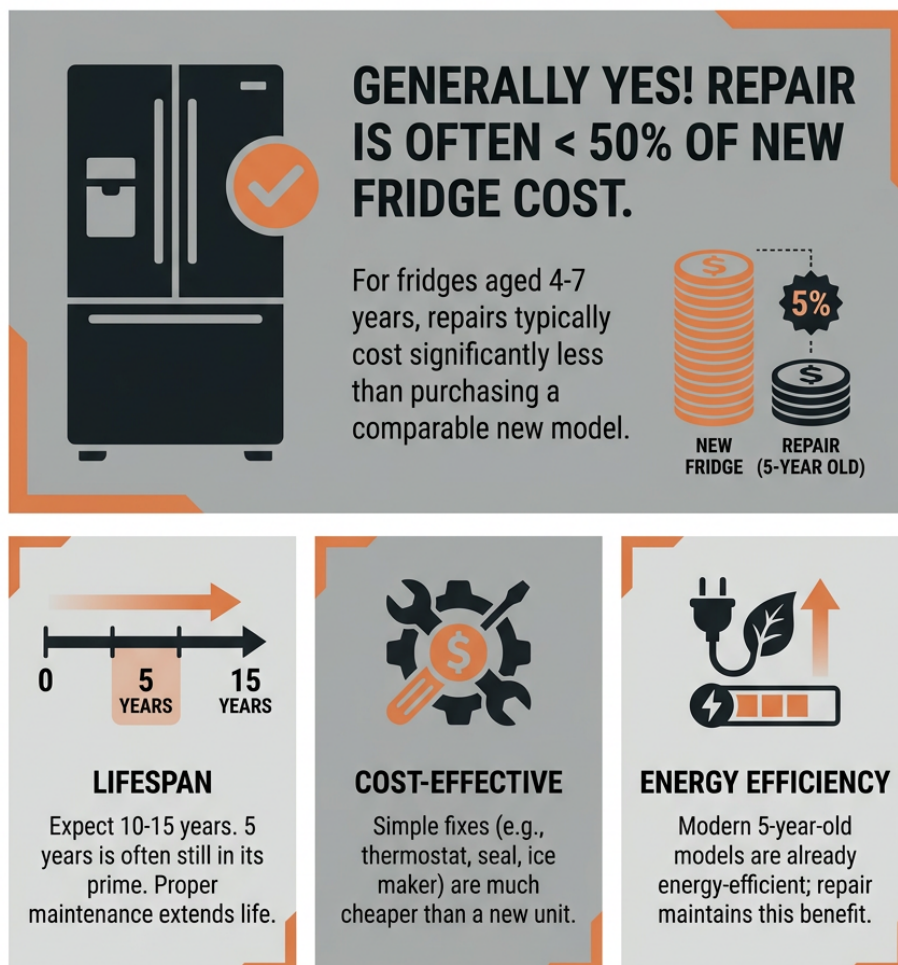
