2. The Split-Bet Strategy

- **Method:** Place two bets of equal size. Set the car cash-out on the first bet to a low-to-moderate level (e.g., 2.00 x) to secure a return of the overall preliminary stake. Let the 2nd bet run manually to chase higher multipliers (10x, 20x, or more).
- **Goal:** Cover the expense of the round early while preserving upside potential for a huge payout.

3. The High-Risk Chaser

- **Strategy:** Ignore automobile cash-outs and by hand ride the wave, intending for the optimum 5,000 x capacity.
- **Goal:** Hit a life-altering multiplier.
- **Danger:** Extremely high volatility. Most rounds will end in losses before reaching high numbers.
