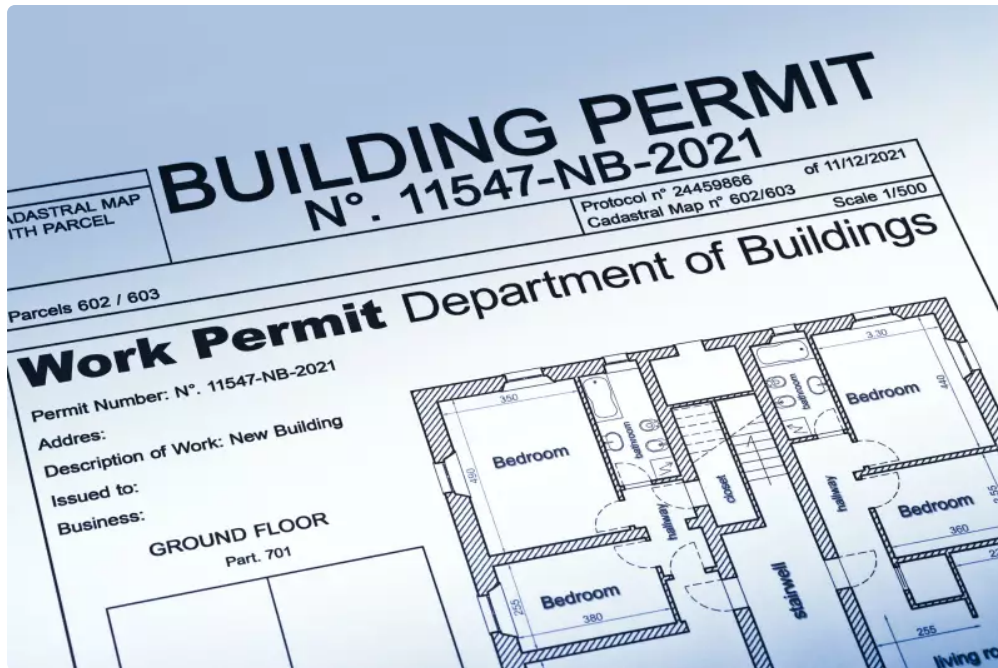

1 Changes During the Construction Phase

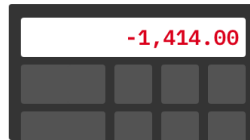
Numerous factors could lead to change orders:

You have to be able to certify sufficient funds are available to undertake projects and make payroll, ensuring building doesn't cease and timelines don't erupt.



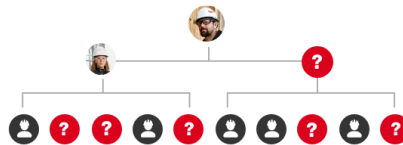
3 Payment Delay

- Honest mistakes



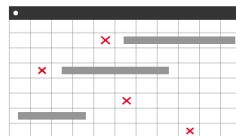
6 Poor Tendering (Bid) Documents
