Field-Tested (FEET)	0.15-- 0.38	Obvious scratches and use on prominent edges and paint.
Well-Worn (WW)	0.38-- 0.45	Considerable wear, paint fading, and noticeable scratches throughout the body.
Battle-Scarred (BS)	0.45-- 1.00	Heavily distressed, rusted, or peeling paint. (Some skins look surprisingly cool in this condition!)
