I use brick-lay styles to diffuse element lines and steer clear of stack marks. Even pressure is vital. Endpaper manner things more than maximum observe. Fishhooks aren't a mystery, they come from ends bending again on themselves. I select a double endpaper wrap on layered hair, mainly when Face Frame Highlights have left the front greater mushy.
