## Understand the Main Types of Moving Services

Commercial movers assist businesses with offices, retail locations, warehouses, restaurants, medical facilities, studios, and other professional properties. They may transport desks, equipment, inventory, shelving, fixtures, documents, technology, and supplies.



Office moving companies focus on workplace relocations. Their services may include packing departments, labeling workstations, disassembling cubicles, protecting computers, transporting furniture, handling documents, and setting up the new office.

## Solutions for Businesses

Businesses should begin with an inventory of furniture, technology, files, equipment, supplies, merchandise, and fixtures. Identify what will be transported, stored, donated, recycled, sold, or discarded.

A moving coordinator should communicate with the moving company, employees, building managers, technology providers, vendors, and business owners. This person can help answer questions, confirm schedules, and approve changes.

The company should prepare a floor plan for the new location. Items can be labeled by department, room, floor, employee, or workstation. This helps movers place items correctly and allows employees to return to work more quickly.



## Office Packing and Technology Handling

Office furniture and equipment should be packed according to size, weight, fragility, and function. Desks, cabinets, conference tables, cubicles, computers, printers, servers, files, and office supplies may require different handling methods.

Businesses should decide who will disconnect and reconnect technology. This may be handled by an internal technology team, an outside provider, or a moving company with suitable experience. Important data should be backed up before devices are disconnected.

Confidential files, employee records, customer information, contracts, financial documents, keys, access cards, and security codes should remain under controlled supervision throughout the relocation.

## Commercial Relocation for Growing Companies

Business expansion may create the need for a larger office, a new store, a warehouse, or an additional facility. A relocation can support growth, but poor planning may cause delays, damaged property, employee confusion, and service interruptions.

Commercial movers can help transport heavy or oversized items such as machinery, shelving, pallets, inventory, restaurant equipment, display cases, and office furniture. These belongings may require disassembly, protective

wrapping, specialty tools, or additional labor.

## **Coordinate With Property Managers**

Commercial and residential properties may have strict moving requirements. Confirm loading dock schedules, freight elevators, parking spaces, security check-in, access cards, floor protection, and permitted moving hours.

For offices and commercial properties, ask about certificates, after-hours access, freight elevator reservations, loading routes, and protection for walls and floors. For apartments, confirm the designated entrance, elevator window, parking space, and building contact.

Sharing accurate access information with the moving company helps prevent waiting time and ensures that the crew arrives prepared for the property.

## **Compare Moving Estimates**
