

A dead thermostat at noon on a 95-degree July afternoon is the kind of problem that tests patience and household relationships. If the system cycles but produces reduced cooling, and you can tolerate slightly higher indoor temperatures for a day, schedule next-day service and use fans, window shades, and targeted cooling in occupied rooms.

Examples where same-day is a clear call: complete loss of cooling during high outdoor temperature, the presence of a burning or metallic smell at the air handler, loud banging or grinding noises that suggest mechanical failure. Examples where same-day may not be necessary: thermostat batteries exhausted, filter soiled causing airflow restriction, or minor refrigerant charge drift where the system still cools slowly.

Preparing before you call A technician's time is most efficient when basic information is available up front.
