When a lock change is the wrong move

For many properties, that gives a cleaner security reset without the expense of replacing every lock on the door. It is not a cure for every problem, though, because damaged hardware, worn cylinders, or broken parts can still call for repair or replacement.

Residential, commercial, and automotive needs

Vehicles bring a different kind of urgency, because a car lockout or lost key situation can stop the day immediately. The old key no longer fits, the sticky deadbolt turns again, or the broken lock gets replaced before it causes a bigger issue. When that happens, the service is doing exactly what it should.
