What our soil and climate ask of us

Most Gretna neighborhoods sit on loess-derived silt loams. At the floor, the texture feels powdery when dry and sticky after a rain. Under that layer you in most cases hit a denser clay horizon. Now keep watch over the water. New seed needs regularly occurring, shallow moisture, now not soaks.
