## The Step-by-Step DIY Window and Door Tune-Up

### 1. Check and Replace Weatherstripping

Over time, weatherstripping compresses and loses its bounce.

- **How to repair:** Peel away the old product, clean the channel with rubbing alcohol, and push brand-new self-adhesive V-strip or foam tape into place.

### 2. Oil Moving Parts

Squeaky hinges and persistent sliding tracks just need a little lubrication.

- **How to repair:** Avoid sticky oils like WD-40 on tracks, as they bring in dust and dirt. Instead, use a silicone-based spray or graphite powder on tracks, hinges, and lock mechanisms to guarantee smooth operation.

### 3. Caulk Gaps Around Frames

Outside spaces let water permeate into walls, causing structural damage.

- **How to fix:** Scrape away old, cracked exterior caulk. Use a bead of state-of-the-art, paintable exterior silicone-acrylic latex caulk along the frame joints, smoothing it out with a damp finger or caulking tool.

### 4. Change Door Hinges

Drooping doors typically have loose screws or a hinge that requires stress adjustment.

- **How to fix:** Tighten loose screws. If the holes are removed, remove the screw, insert a little piece of wood toothpick covered in wood glue into the hole, and re-insert the screw for a tight grip.

Property owners must carry out a visual evaluation twice a year-- ideally in the spring and fall before severe weather condition sets in. Checking seals, lubricating moving parts, and clearing particles from tracks yearly will dramatically extend their life expectancy.

### Are breezy doors an indication that I need a whole new door?

Not always. Most drafts are easily cured by changing the bottom sweep, changing the threshold, or setting up fresh weatherstripping around the frame.
