Popular Strategies for CS: GO Crash

1. The Conservative Auto-Cashout Strategy

- **The Concept:** Wait for rounds where low multipliers have dominated and aim for enormous multipliers (50x+).
- **The Pros:** Extremely high payout if effective.
- **The Cons:** Statistically unusual; the vast bulk of these efforts result in a lost bet.
