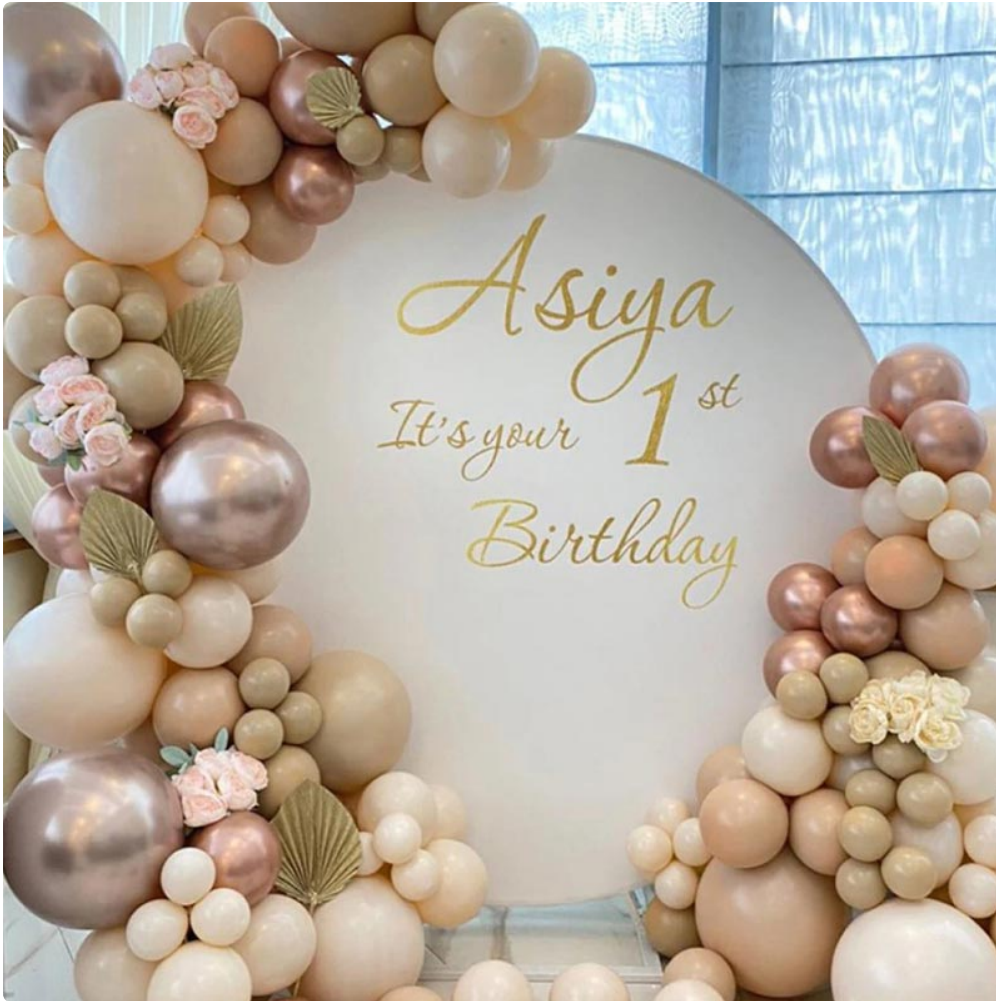

1. Backyard Scavenger Hunt

And it gets kids outside and active. Like a smooth rock, a yellow flower, a pinecone, and a leaf. So they can easily identify the items. For older kids, add challenges. And have a prize for the first team to find everything. Make it a themed hunt. For collecting items. This hunt is perfect for ages 3–8

2. The Rainy Day Activity

Or for a party that's held indoors. Or hide items for kids to find. Or "find something that is soft". Like "I have a face and two hands, but no arms or legs" (a clock). Set up teams. Like a "detective hunt" or a "treasure hunt". Use clues that lead to a final treasure. This hunt is perfect for ages 3–12

3. The Digital Adventure

Like "a selfie with a stranger," "a funny face," "a team jump," and "a photo with a pet". Divide teens into teams. And have them meet back at the starting point. For a more competitive version. Like Instagram or a private group. Where they have to find specific [Kollysphere Agency](#) locations. This hunt is perfect for ages 12–18

4. The Community Adventure

A neighborhood scavenger hunt is perfect for kids and teens. Like a red door, a garden gnome, a specific street sign, and a birdhouse. Or "find the park with the big slide". With adult supervision. And have a prize for the first team to find everything. Like a "history hunt" or a "nature hunt". And have a meeting point. This hunt is perfect for ages 6–14

5. A Race for Gold

A treasure hunt is a classic scavenger hunt. Create a map with clues. Each clue leads to the next location. With pictures and easy riddles. This adds a mental challenge. Like a "pirate treasure hunt" or a "jungle treasure hunt". This ensures everyone feels like a winner. And it's great for a pirate, jungle, or adventure-themed party

6. Alphabet Scavenger Hunt

An alphabet scavenger hunt is perfect for younger kids. Create a list of items that start with each letter of the alphabet. For younger kids, use pictures instead of words. The first team to complete the alphabet wins. Make it a themed hunt. For collecting items. And it's great for a preschool or kindergarten party

7. Color Scavenger Hunt

And it helps with color recognition. And have kids find items that match each color. This is easy and visual. For older kids, make it a race. This adds an outdoor element. And have a "color collage" at the end. This hunt is perfect for ages 2–5

8. A Race to Count

And it helps with number recognition and counting. Like 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5. Like "find 1 ball," "find 2 books," and "find 3 toys". This adds a math element. Set a time limit. Like a "counting hunt" or a "math hunt". Provide small bags or buckets. And it's great for a math or science-themed party

9. The Touch and Feel Adventure

It's tactile, fun, and educational. Like soft, rough, smooth, bumpy, and fuzzy. Like a soft stuffed animal, a rough rock, and a smooth leaf. For older kids, make it a challenge. Set a time limit. This adds variety. For collecting items. This hunt is perfect for ages 2–5

10. A Race for Information

An internet scavenger hunt is perfect for teens. Like "find a picture of a red panda," "find a recipe for chocolate chip cookies," and "find a video of a baby laughing". And give each team a computer or tablet. And have them submit their findings. Assign points to each item. This adds an educational element. To submit answers. Or a school event

11. A Race for Snacks

It's delicious and fun. Create a list of food items to find. Like "find the table with the cookies". The first team to find everything wins. Or "find foods from different countries". Set up a "snack table" at the end. Like a "healthy

food hunt" or a "dessert hunt". And it's great for a cooking or food-themed party

12. A Hunt Designed for Your Party

A custom scavenger hunt is the ultimate personalized activity. And create clues and items that match. Create a list of items or clues. And have them race to complete the hunt. This makes it age-appropriate. And small prizes for everyone. By adding costumes, decorations, and music. And it's great for any party theme
