3. Look for explicit RTP percentages and volatility levels (e.g., low, medium, high).
4. Beware of sites that only list RTP deep in FAQs or require you to download PDFs. That's less transparency.

Both PlayGrand and 32Red comply well with transparent disclosures, but subtle differences exist in how user-friendly their information layouts are.

PlayGrand frequently updates their portfolio, meaning players get a fresh selection that balances blockbuster names and innovative themes.

Transparency and RTP on PlayGrand

PlayGrand displays RTP accessibly within the in-game info panels. You'll almost never need to hunt for RTP beyond a single click from the game screen. Volatility ratings are usually provided too, offering a clear picture to manage bankroll volatility—a vital factor for long-run enjoyment.

32Red Library Size: Depth and Substance

32Red is a stalwart of the UK online casino scene, with a history of solid regulatory compliance and player trust. Their game library size often clocks just shy of **700 slots**, emphasizing quantity alongside quality.

- **Slots:** Encompasses classic slots, video slots, jackpot games, and progressive jackpots.
- **Live Casino:** Extensive live dealer portfolio including poker variations, blackjack, and more.
- **Providers:** Similar to PlayGrand but with a slightly wider inclusion of niche providers for variety.

32Red also holds the Guinness World Record for a highly publicized massive jackpot win, which adds to its appeal for jackpot hunters.

How 32Red Handles RTP Visibility

While 32Red meets UKGC standards for RTP display, occasionally the RTP info can be buried a tad too deep in the help menu or external paytables, rather than immediate in-game info icons. This is not a red flag but slightly less user-friendly than PlayGrand's streamlined approach.

Players preferring quick access to volatility and RTP data might find this a minor inconvenience, especially when assessing games on the fly.
