Using third-party trading and case-opening sites does not straight lead to a Valve Anti-Cheat (VAC) restriction. Nevertheless, Valve sometimes updates its terms of service or prohibits API secrets associated with automatic trading bots, which can momentarily disrupt your ability to trade skins.
