Do not force a stuck door or disconnect safety mechanisms to make it operate. If the door is crooked, suddenly heavy, unusually loud, or hanging from one side, stop using it and schedule an inspection.

When to Call for Garage Door Spring Replacement Near Me

Homeowners often search for **garage door spring replacement near me** after hearing a sudden pop or finding that the door will not lift. A torsion spring is mounted above the door and twists to store energy. An extension spring is positioned along the horizontal tracks and stretches as the door moves. Overhead Garage Door and Garage Door Panel Repair Options
