4. Heat, vacuum, and pressure balanced for our climate

You can hear a powerful truckmount from the driveway, but raw power isn't enough. Carpet cleaners require to stabilize 3 variables: heat, water pressure, and vacuum. Excessive heat can set certain dyes or affect protectants. Excessive pressure can drive soil much deeper and overwet the backing, especially in older homes where the carpet padding has softened. Weak vacuum leaves excess moisture behind.

In St George, dry time matters. Our low humidity helps, but so does smart method. Good professionals make a final "dry pass" with each stroke, move slower on the extraction pass than on the spray pass, and utilize glides on their wands to enhance air flow. It soaks through the backing and into the pad, where crystallized salts keep pulling moisture from the air and releasing smell again and once again. Spraying a deodorizer on the surface will not fix it.

The right method depends on seriousness. For light accidents, an enzymatic pre-spray and extensive rinse might do it. For repeated areas in the same area, I try to find companies that can perform subsurface extraction. This involves saturating the location with an option created to break down salts and bacteria, then extracting from below the backing with a specialized tool that pulls liquid from the pad. It's not glamorous, however it works. For severe cases, the only honest option is to pull the carpet, replace the afflicted pad, seal the subfloor, and re-install. 6. Regard for your home: defense, containment, and cleanup

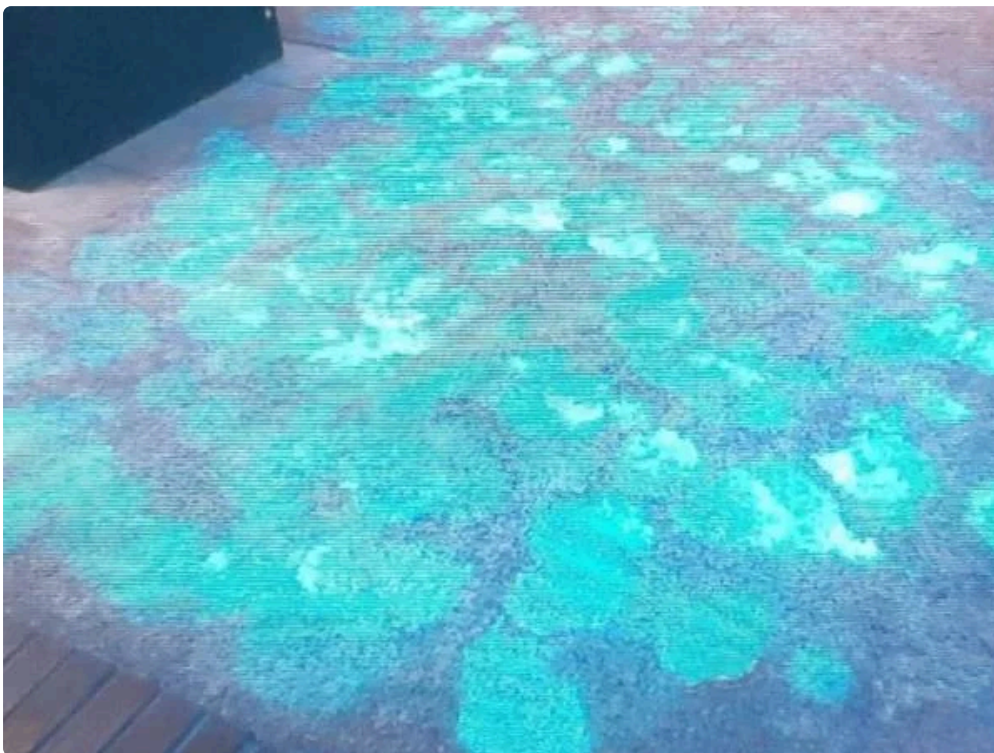
