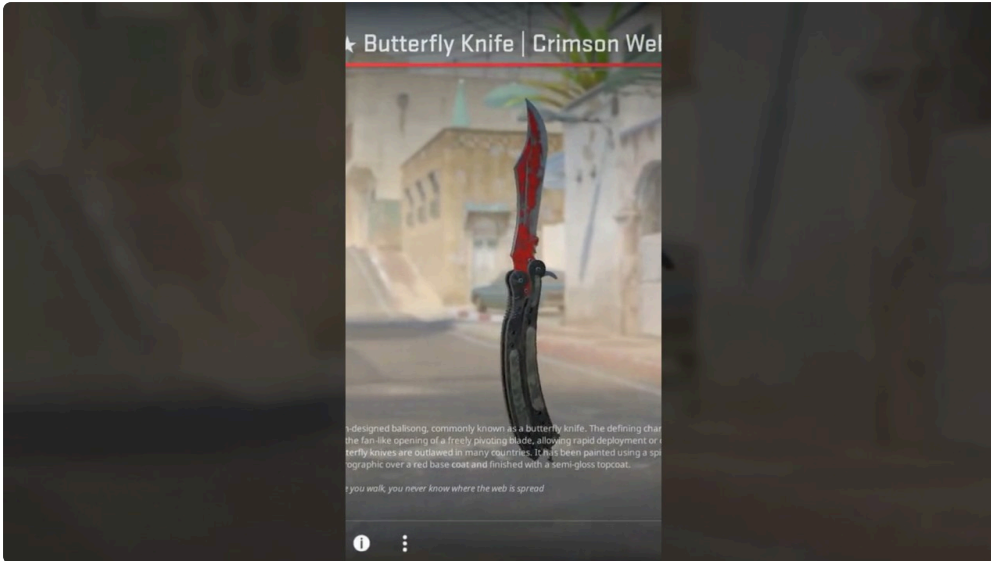


## Everything You Need to Know About CS: GO Case Keys
